Managing Behaviour and Acceptable Restraints

Unacceptable behaviour to be disciplined by the following progression:-

1. Verbal warning (advise pupil that they will only be warned a further two times and if they continue after that they will be asked to sit out of the class.
2. Sitting out for a period of minutes (advise pupil of the amount of minutes they have been told to sit on the side of the pool and why) ask for apology before entry back into the class.
3. Unacceptable behaviour continues – the pupil is told to leave and returned to the parent who must take them to the changing room for dressing.
4. Physical aggression towards staff or other pupils/members of the school will result in dismissal from the class – pupil to be returned to parent to take back to the changing room for dressing.
5. No physical restraint (with exception of item 6) or tower domination is acceptable by pupil, staff or members.
6. Physical aggressive contact between two bodies must be separated by a third party between the two people – the two parties told to leave the school immediately pending further enquiry. Reasonable restraint may only be used on separation.

Actions 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 must be reported to J A Coe who will follow up and take necessary action following discussion with all concerned.
