Personal Coaching

A teacher may highlight a pupil would benefit from one-one (lesson(s). This would be discussed with J A Coe and the parent/guardian.

One-One teaching will take place if a pupil is seriously struggling within a group and permission is granted by J A Coe who will be the only person to contact the parent/guardian to arrange such lesson(s).

The procedure for one-one lessons is:-

- The lesson will be conducted at either The Swimming Academy premises with lifeguard at poolside or at public pool where members of the public and lifeguards will be present.
- 2. Parent will prepare pupil for the lesson in the changing room.
- 3. The teacher will collect the pupil from the changing room/parent and take to poolside where equipment such as a swim belt or arm rings are placed on the pupil.
- 4. Parent will proceed to the spectator's gallery where they are able to watch the lesson take place.
- 5. At the end of the lesson, the pupil will be wrapped in a towel for warmth (when at a public pool) and walked back to the changing room where they will be returned to the parent who will change the pupil.
